The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers guidance for design of riprap in flood control channels is found in Engineer Manual (EM) 1110-2-1601 (J). This guidance is a departure from the traditional guidance based on shear stress or tractive force and uses a procedure based on local depth-averaged velocity.
