Vocabulary is acquired incidentally through indirect exposure to words and intentionally through explicit instruction in specific words and word-learning strategies. According to Michael Graves (2000), there are four components of an effective vocabulary program:

When choosing which words to explicitly teach, include words from academic word lists. These words, typically conceptual words, cross academic disciplines. For example, this list of academic words (Coxhead, 2000) will occur in texts in language arts and in content areas. This presents a logical opportunity for explicit vocabulary instruction.

How to Pre-Teach Key Vocabulary to English Language ...

Write each vocabulary word in a sentence that gives contextual clues to the word's meaning. Contextual clues are words and phrases around an unknown word that point to the word's meaning. For example, if the vocabulary word is "succinct," you might write, "Julia gave a succinct presentation and the meeting was over in no time."

What words do I teach? Knowing what words to teach is the first step in providing effective vocabulary practice. I have a favorite mnemonic device that helps me remember the types of words I want to teach explicitly: Type A Words: These words are like Type A personalities. They work hard in order to convey the meaning of the text being read.

Explicitly teaching parts of words is one of the best activities for teaching vocabulary. When you teach parts of words such as the root (or base), prefixes and suffixes, you are teaching a skill that covers both Tier 2 and Tier 3 words. Students learn to use word parts to recognize unfamiliar, or rare, words and to construct meaning from them.

Word Learning for Children - Vocabulary Activities & More

Vocabulary is an important focus of literacy teaching and refers to the knowledge of words, including their structure (morphology), use (grammar), meanings (semantics), and links to other words (word/semantic relationships). Oral vocabulary refers to words that children can understand or use while speaking and listening.

Teachers can use devices for vocabulary teaching such as simple flash-cards or word-cards. The teacher writes the English language word on one side of the card and a sentence containing the word, its definition, its synonyms and pronunciation on the other. Word cards can be an excellent memory aid.

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
